**TO CONTROL HELIOTHIS, LIGHTBROWN APPLE MOTH,  
LUCERNE LEAF ROLLER AND VEGETABLE WEEVIL IN CELERY**

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows any person to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

## CONDITIONS OF USE

### Product to be used:

AVATAR INSECTICIDE (APVMA No. 52546)

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 300 g/kg INDOXACARB as the only active constituent.

### Directions for Use:

Crop Type	Insect Pest	Application Rate
CELERY	HELIOTHIS & LUCERNE LEAF ROLLER	170 or 250 g/ha or 25g/100 L water
	VEGETABLE WEEVIL	250 g/ha or 25 g/100 L water
	LIGHTBROWN APPLE MOTH	12.5 g/100 L water

### Critical Use Comments:

- Apply using a boom-spray, air-blast sprayer or similar equipment in spray volume of 150-1000 L/ha. Add a non-ionic surfactant at 15 g active/100 L spray solution.
- DO NOT apply more than three (3) applications per crop with a minimum re-treatment interval of seven (7) days between sprays.

### Withholding Period:

DO NOT APPLY LATER THAN 7 DAYS BEFORE HARVEST.

### Jurisdiction:

All States and Territories, except VIC.

Note: Victoria is not included in this permit, as their Control-of-Use legislation means a permit is not required to legalise this off-label use in that State.

### Additional Conditions:

This PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

PERSONS who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the DETAILS and CONDITIONS of this permit.

### Export of treated produce

To allow produce from treated plants to be supplied or otherwise made available for human consumption the APVMA has established a temporary maximum residue limit (TMRL) of 5mg/kg for indoxacarb in celery. This limit applies only to produce marketed and consumed in Australia. If treated produce is to be exported due account should therefore be taken of the residue definition and residue limits/import tolerances of importing countries and that any residues must not exceed those requirements of the importing country.
