Product to be used:

DUSTING SULPHUR 900 FUNGICIDE-MITICIDE (58337)

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 900 g/kg SULFUR as the only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

Crop	Pest	Rate
Treatment of banana bunches	Mites (<i>Tetranychus lambi</i> and <i>T. Urtica</i>)	10g dust per bunch

Critical Use Comments:

- Apply using duster shortly after bell emergence. Do not exceed 10g per bunch.
- Apply dust evenly to avoid heavy localised deposits which will result in unwanted visual residues of sulphur.
- Application is to be confined to fruit, avoiding leaves as much as possible as sulphur deposits will interfere with beneficial insect activity.

Jurisdiction:

NSW, QLD only.

Additional Conditions:

This permit provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.
