FOR THE SUPPRESSION OF PHYTOPHTHORA IN ALMONDS

CONDITIONS OF USE

Products to be used:

ALL REGISTERED products containing PHOSPHOROUS ACID at a level of 400, 460, 600, 620 or 625 g/L present as MONO- AND DI-POTASSIUM PHOSPHONATE, and PHOSPHOROUS ACID at 500 g/L present as MONO- AND DI-AMMONIUM, POTASSIUM and SODIUM PHOSPHONATES

Critical Use Comments:

- Ensure thorough coverage of foliage and branches. Spray to the point of run-off using air blast sprayer or equivalent equipment.
- DO NOT apply more than two (2) applications per season.
- DO NOT apply after hull split
- DO NOT apply under high temperatures particularly if humidity is low.

Withholding Period:

DO NOT harvest for 28 DAYS after application.

Jurisdiction:

ALL STATES except VIC.

Note: Victoria is not included in this permit, as their *Control-of-Use* legislation means a permit is not required to legalise this off-label use in that state.

Additional Conditions:

This PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the DETAILS and CONDITIONS of this permit.
