



**PERMIT TO ALLOW MINOR USE OF AN AGVET CHEMICAL PRODUCT
FOR THE CONTROL OF VARIOUS INSECT PESTS IN OLIVE PLANTATIONS**

PERMIT NUMBER – PER14575

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows any person to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

NUFARM CHLORPYRIFOS 500 EC INSECTICIDE (APVMA No. 32902)

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 500 g/L CHLORPYRIFOS as their only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

Olives	Ants	100 mL per 100 L water	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Apply as a ground and butt treatment using 1000L of spray mixture/ha to ground beneath trees, and 1.5L per butt applied to lower buttsDO NOT apply more than two applications per season to trees that are of fruit-bearing age
	African Black Beetle		<ul style="list-style-type: none">Apply as a soil drench around the base of the treeDO NOT apply more than two applications per season to trees that are of fruit bearing age
	Light Brown Apple Moth		<ul style="list-style-type: none">Apply as a foliar spray to non-fruit bearing trees only

Withholding Periods:

Harvest:

Ground and Butt treatments (Ants and African black beetle):
NOT REQUIRED WHEN USED AS DIRECTED.

Foliar applications (LBAM):

Only apply to non-fruit bearing trees and DO NOT APPLY WITHIN 12 MONTHS OF HARVEST.

Grazing/stockfeed:

DO NOT GRAZE OR CUT TREATED AREAS FOR STOCKFEED.

Jurisdiction:

ACT, NSW, QLD, SA, TAS, NT & WA ONLY.

(Note: Victoria is not included in this permit because their "Control-of-Use" legislation means that a permit is not required to legalise this off-label use on VIC).

Additional Conditions:

THIS PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

PERSONS who wish to prepare for use and/or use the products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the permit particularly the information included in DETAILS OF PERMIT and CONDITIONS OF PERMIT.

Export of Treated Produce:

To allow produce from treated plants to be supplied or otherwise made available for consumption the APVMA has established the following maximum residue limits (MRLs) for chlorpyrifos in Olives at T*0.05 mg/kg.

This limit applies only to produce marketed and consumed in Australia. Therefore if treated produce is to be exported, due account should be taken of the residue definition and residue limits/import tolerances of importing countries and that any residues must not exceed those requirements of the importing country.

Other Matters:

Continued issuance of this Permit is subject to the outcomes of the current review of CHLORPYRIFOS FINAL STAGE, as notified in the October 2000 Gazette on page 37. The review of CHLORPYRIFOS FINAL STAGE (Review Id = 99) covers all registrations and approvals. All active constituents, products, labels and permits are included in the review.
