



PERMIT TO ALLOW MINOR USE OF AN AGVET CHEMICAL PRODUCT
FOR THE CONTROL OF ECTROPIS LOOPER ON AVOCADO

PERMIT NUMBER - PER14597

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. Products to be used:

LANNATE-L INSECTICIDE (APVMA No. 47336)

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 225 g/L METHOMYL as the only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

Crop	Insect Pest	Rate
AVOCADO	ECTROPIS LOOPER (<i>Ectropis sabulosa</i>)	Apply at a rate of 50-100 mL product per 100 L water.

Critical Use Comments:

- Apply as a cover spray to point of run-off as required.
- Use the higher rate on large loopers or on heavy infestations.
- Keep animals and unprotected persons out of operational areas during treatment and while there is any danger of drift. Refer to '*Precautions*', '*Protections*' and '*Safety directions*' on the product label.

Withholding Period:

DO NOT apply later than 3 DAYS before harvest.

Jurisdiction:

NSW & QLD only.

Additional Conditions:

This permit provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit.

Export of Produce:

If treated produce is to be exported, due account should be taken of the residue definition and residue limits/import tolerances of importing countries.
