**PERMIT TO ALLOW MINOR USE OF AN AGVET CHEMICAL PRODUCT
FOR THE CONTROL OF MAIZE RUST IN SWEET CORN**

PERMIT NUMBER – PER86245

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder under Section 112 of the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code, scheduled to the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code Act 1994 (the Agvet Code) of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows any person to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

CONDITIONS OF USE

Product to be used:

VERITAS FUNGICIDE (APVMA No. 82348)

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS Containing: 120 g/L AZOXYSTROBIN and 200 g/L TEBUCONAZOLE as the only active constituents.

Directions for Use:

Situation	Pest	Rate
Sweet corn	Maize Rust (<i>Puccinia spp.</i>)	0.65 - 0.95 L/ha

Critical Use Comments:

- **Ground application:** apply in at least 100 L water per hectare.
- **Aerial application:** apply in at least 30 L water per hectare.
- Apply when conditions favour disease development.
- Use lower application rate under conditions of low disease, or prior to or following wet weather. Use higher application rate where low disease is present prior to or immediately following wet weather.
- 7-14 day re-treatment interval (the shorter interval recommended when conditions are conducive to disease infection).
- DO NOT apply more than three (3) applications per crop. DO NOT apply more than two consecutive applications.
- DO NOT use adjuvants or crop oil after the V8 stage and prior to the VT stage (after BBCH18 and prior to BBCH51).
- Adhere to spray drift restraints and mandatory no-spray zones (as listed for peanuts) on the product label.
- DO NOT contaminate wetlands or watercourses with this product or used containers. DO NOT apply if heavy rain or storms that are likely to cause runoff are forecast within 3 days.
- DO NOT allow re-entry to treated areas until the spray has dried unless wearing protective clothing. Refer to product label.

Jurisdiction:

ALL STATES, except Vic.

Note: Victoria is not included in this permit, as their Control-of-Use legislation means a permit is not required to legalise this off-label use in that state.

Withholding periods:

Harvest: DO NOT harvest for 7 days after application.

Grazing: DO NOT graze or cut for stock feed for 7 days after last application.

Additional Conditions:

This permit provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit.
