### Product to be used:

ANTHEM 100 INSECTICIDE (69556)

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 100 g/L FIPRONIL as their only active constituent.

RAYSTAR FIPRONIL 200SC INSECTICIDE (85304)

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 200 g/L FIPRONIL as their only active constituent.

KENSO AGCARE BRUTUS 800 INSECTICIDE (68695)

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 800 g/kg FIPRONIL as their only active constituent.

### Directions for Use:

Carrots	White fringed weevil ( <i>Naupactus leucoloma</i> )	<b><u>100 g/L product:</u></b> 1 L/ha
	Symphylids ( <i>Symphyla</i> )	<b><u>200 g/L product:</u></b> 500 mL/ha
		<b><u>800 g/kg product:</u></b> 125 g/ha

### Critical Use Comments:

- Apply as a broadcast spray to the surface of the soil and incorporate to a depth of 15 cm prior to planting
- Apply a maximum of 1 (one) application per crop.
- Apply by boom sprayer or equivalent in a spray volume of 100L/ha.

### Withholding Period:

Harvest: Not required when used as directed.

Grazing: Do not graze or cut for stock food any part of a failed crop (including culls).

### Jurisdiction:

ALL STATES, except VIC.

Note: Victoria is not included in this permit as their *Control-of-Use* legislation means that an APVMA permit is not required to legalise this off-label use in that state.

### Additional Conditions:

This Permit provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit.

***Export of treated produce:***

*Treated crop commodities destined for export may require extra time being allowed between application and harvest, to be accepted in some export markets.
