



PERMIT TO ALLOW MINOR USE OF AN AGVET CHEMICAL PRODUCT

**FOR CONTROL OF SELECTED BROADLEAF WEEDS IN SPRING ONION,
WELSH ONION AND SHALLOTS**

PERMIT NUMBER – PER14142

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows any person to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

Products to be used:

TOTRIL SELECTIVE HERBICIDE [APVMA No. 31729]

Containing: 250 g/L IOXYNIL present as OCTANOATE as the only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

Crop	Target Weeds	Application Rate
SPRING ONION SHALLOT WELSH ONION	BROADLEAF WEEDS As per product label	2.1 - 2.8 L product / ha

Critical Use Comments:

- Apply between the 3 and 8 leaf stage of the crop, and between the cotyledon and 6-leaf stage of the weeds.
- Apply a maximum of two (2) applications with a re-treatment interval of 14-21 days where wireweed is dominant, or weeds are more mature.
- Ensure adequate spray penetration to obtain effective control of the target weeds.
- DO NOT apply under weather conditions, or from spraying equipment, that may cause drift onto nearby susceptible plants/crops, cropping lands or pastures.

Withholding Period:

Harvest: DO NOT harvest for 21 DAYS after application.

Jurisdiction:

ALL STATES except VIC.

Note: Victoria is not included in this permit, as their Control-of-Use legislation means a permit is not required to legalise this off-label use in that state.

Additional Conditions:

This PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

PERSONS who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the DETAILS and CONDITIONS of this permit.

To avoid crop damage:

The sensitivity of some species and varieties of the crops to be treated under this permit has not been fully evaluated. Slight scorching or symptoms of wilting may occur but this is transient as subsequent growth and yield is unaffected. It is advisable, therefore, to only treat a small number of plants to ascertain their reaction before treating the whole crop.
