

9.1 Total Australian Horticultural Exports

For the year ending June 2025, Australian horticultural exports totalled \$3,778.7 million, with fresh fruit representing the highest value export grouping. The following chart and table provide a detailed breakdown of export values by category group, highlighting the top three export categories within each group.
