Overview

The inaugural Avocado Strategic Investment Advisory Panel (SIAP) meeting addressed the governance requirements of the new advisory mechanism that Hort Innovation works within.

An induction into the new model and robust discussion about the role of the SIAP and appropriate communication avenues were held.

The financial position of the Avocado levy program was presented with all the information available on the Hort Innovation website.

The meeting then progressed to an update and workshop session on the Strategic Investment Plan (SIP) – covering topics such as:

- Exports
- Irregular bearing
- Quality
- Consistent supply, data collation and productivity.

Concepts submitted through the Hort Innovation were also covered including: Infocado, Orchardinfo and cover crops.

Finally, the marketing plan for 2016/17 was presented, including the review details of the previous iteration and timeline of activities such as the TV Campaign and social media pillars.
