Overview

Hort Innovation convened a meeting of the Melon SIAP via teleconference on January 18, 2018. The primary aim of this meeting was to review, discuss and seek advice from the panel on concept proposals received by Hort Innovation.

The panel was given an update on the progression of the Strategic Investment Plan (SIP) currently being completed by Brian Ramsay and Invoact Consulting.

- Integrated control of phytoparasitic nematodes in NT
- Gummy Stem Blight control options
- Mon Quality and Safety program
- Nematode control options in horticultural crops.
