Overview

The persimmon Strategic Investment Advisory Panel (SIAP) met to review, discuss and provide advice on the current and future investment program. The inputs into the meeting included details on the financial position of the strategic levy, proposed investment and a gap analysis against the Strategic Investment Plan (SIP). The SIAP were provided an update on the investment program since the previous meeting.

One of the key focus areas of the day was a workshop session led by consultants McKinna et al to review the draft export strategy for persimmons. The draft will be finalised with the feedback from the SIAP incorporated and then provide the industry with an export strategy.

The Strategic Marketing Plan was presented and discussed with the panel and the input and advice will be incorporated into the approach for the marketing campaign. Regular communication during the season will occur so that the industry is aware of the season activity will occur, particularly with no conference occurring in 2019.
