The inaugural meeting addressed governance, roles and responsibilities and outlined the strategic focus of the panel.

The marketing program included a recap of the 2015/16 financial year and an outline of the 2016/17 financial year and was presented by the marketing manager Gustavo Soares highlighting the #endlessSummer opportunity for pineapples.

The current program overview included the presentation of the financial position, concepts and current projects and summaries which lead into discussion of the Strategic Investment Plan (SIP). This prioritisation process and review of key data was discussed in a workshop style session led by the SIP consultant.
