Overview

Hort Innovation convened a meeting of the processed potato Strategic Investment Advisory Panel (SIAP) in conjunction with the potato growing SIAP in Sydney on 17 and 18 January 2018.

The meeting was held over a day and a half with the first ½ day session being dedicated to the discussion of a potential Programmed Approach for the Potato sector.

The Programmed Approach has been discussed as a vehicle for the current projects and future projects as an umbrella for the management of these projects.

This session was also attended by a number of external potato research experts. Discussions are ongoing on the Programmed Approach with Hort Innovation to develop a Request for Proposal (RFP) in the next 2 weeks.

On day two of the meeting the panel received project updates from current service providers regarding the following.

- National Tomato Potato Psyllid and Zebra Chip Surveillance
- Seed Potato Stewardship - Potato Certified Seed Care for Optimum Yield and Profitability

There was also discussion on some concepts that have been received with two (2) of the concepts moving to the RFP stage. The other concepts are to be further developed in discussion with a Project Reference Group (PRG) in conjunction with the Programmed Approach discussion.
