Overview

Hort Innovation convened a meeting of the inaugural processing tomato Strategic Investment Advisory Panel (SIAP) in Echuca.

The key purpose of the meeting was to:

- 1. Induct the newly formed SIAP
- 2. Seek advice on the processing tomato Strategic Investment Plan (SIP)
- 3. To assess project concepts received by Hort Innovation

The panel was given an extensive induction outlining the organisational governance, funding model, key objectives and communications of Hort Innovation. The panel was also informed of the SIAP's role and operations, governance, membership, and procedures.

The SIAP was given an update on the processing tomato SIP and participated in an extensive discussion on the direction and priorities for strategic investment.

Finally, the panel were asked to provide advice on 2 projects currently being undertaken by Hort Innovation in response to the TPP outbreak, including the processing tomato industry capacity building program, surveillance of tomato potato psyllid in the Eastern States and South Australia, and the national tomato potato psyllid (TPP) program coordinator.

Next steps

Hort Innovation is continuing to work on the development of the processing tomato SIP.
