

Strawberry Strategic Investment Advisory Panel meeting summary

Overview

The panel reviewed the final draft of the strawberry Strategic Investment Plan (SIP) with consultant Brian Ramsay (Innovact) following a SIP Workshop held earlier during the day which included representatives from Strawberries Australia Inc (SAI). Brian provided a summary of feedback received from industry following the recent industry public comment period. Feedback was received from several state associations as well as a number of individuals. This feedback will be incorporated, as appropriate, into the final version of the SIP.

The panel also made recommendations for initial investment priorities using the new SIP. These included the development of a strawberry export plan, variety development program, consumer insights, and health and nutrition attributes of strawberries.

The panel also discussed a number of project concepts including the New Variety Growing Evaluation and the National Strawberry Breeding program.
