Overview

Jenny van de Meeberg (Hort Innovation Trade Manager) provided a further presentation and update on the strawberry export strategy. Discussion occurred regarding the convening of an export working group to take forward evaluation of the plans at a more detailed level and to provide advice to the SIAP on potential future export strategy investments.

Vino Rajandran, Hort Innovation R&D Manager for biotech and plant breeding, gave a presentation on the development of the new breeding project BS17000-National Strawberry Varietal Improvement Program which had not yet been contracted.

The SIAP also conducted a Strategic Investment Plan (SIP) gap analysis and investment prioritisation session.

The panel also discussed several project concepts including virus management in planting materials and on farms; review of the biosecurity plan and management of Xylella disease prevention.
