Summary

The purpose and objectives of the meeting:

- To review the 5 Year Financial Forecast and Strategic Investment Plan analysis on current and future projects including both levy funded and Hort Frontiers.
- To provide a Hort Innovation and key project update for advice on Research & Development (R&D) and marketing concepts.
- To re-confirm Summerfruit SIAP meetings for next 18 months.

Marketing Fund:

- Change from Summerfruit to Stonefruit: The SIAP supports Hort Innovation investigating and then
 changing the terminology from Summerfruit to Stonefruit to reflect the terminology used by
 consumers.
- **Domestic marketing program 2019/20:** The SIAP supports Hort Innovation implementing the domestic marketing program as presented, with:
 - Hort Innovation working with two SIAP panellists to scope the RFP for the instore promotion component giving consideration to pricing of premium fruit and to involving Aldi in instore promotions.
 - Hort Innovation is to reconfirm advice from the SIAP if any component is likely to increase its budget by more than 10%.
- **Export marketing program 2019/20:** The SIAP supports Hort Innovation implementing the export marketing program as presented (Marketing fund).

R&D Fund:

- Asia fruit Logistica and China FVF: The SIAP supports Hort Innovation funding industry attendance at Asia Fruit Logistica and China FVF.
- Market Access Trade Development: The SIAP supports Hort Innovation proceeding to RFP, with the scoping and contracting of new investment to be seamless.
- **Taste Australia Retail R&D:** The SIAP supports Hort Innovation investing in this project from the Summerfruit R&D Fund (content only).



- Across horticulture support for achieving export MRL compliance: The SIAP supports Hort Innovation investing in this concept from the Summerfruit R&D Fund.
- Users Guide for Fumigation of Stonefruit: The SIAP supports Hort Innovation including this work in the scoping for the project replacing SF17000.
- Biosecurity preparedness through developing capacity for In-field detection of Spotted Winged Drosophila: The SIAP supports Hort Innovation investing in this concept from the Summerfruit R&D Fund.
- Mitigating the potential spread of Xylella fastidiosa (Xf) by understanding vectors: The SIAP supports Hort Innovation investing from the Summerfruit R&D Fund.
- Increasing Summerfruit Demand and Consumption: The SIAP does not support Hort Innovation proceeding to RFP because some of the work is already covered and the cost would be too high.
- Inking rain damage on peaches and nectarines: The SIAP does not support Hort Innovation proceeding with this concept as information is already available.
