## Overview

The sweet potato Strategic Investment Advisory Panel (SIAP) convened a meeting in Bundaberg, QLD on June 13, 2017.

The sweet potato meeting held a discussion around the separation of the R&D Levy from the Vegetable levy. There was also discussion on the formation of the Strategic Investment Plan (SIP) and ensuring a collaborative approach with work already done in this space to ensure maximum results for the sweet potato industry.

The SIAP then spent a considerable amount of time, after the initial update from Greg Murdoch on the financials and the SIP, discussing the current marketing program. The success of this current program has allowed Hort Innovation to present to the SIAP the marketing plan for the following 3 years.

The plan was unanimously approved and received a recommendation by the SIAP members.

This SIAP identified a need also in reviewing any new concepts which had been submitted to Hort Innovation through the concept portal as well as directly to the Relationship Manager (RM) Christian Patterson.
